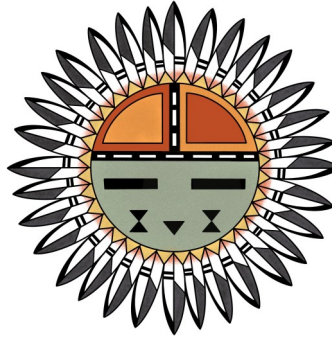

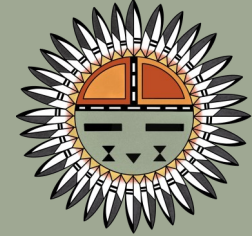

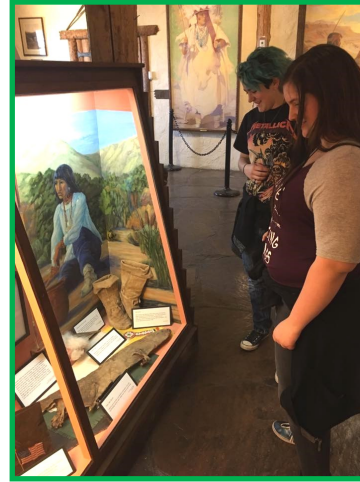


Rewards of Volunteerism

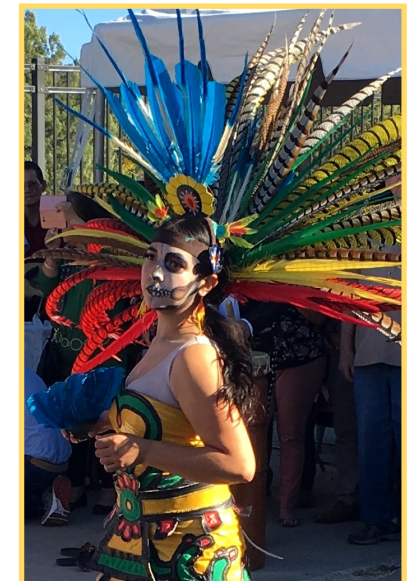
